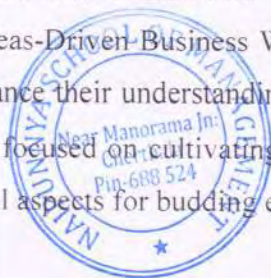

- Ms. Sreelekshmi P P

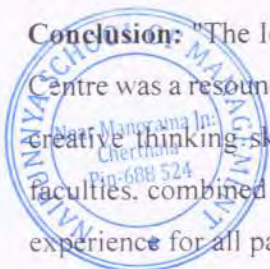
The guiding faculties brought their expertise in business and management to provide valuable insights, guidance, and mentorship throughout the workshop.

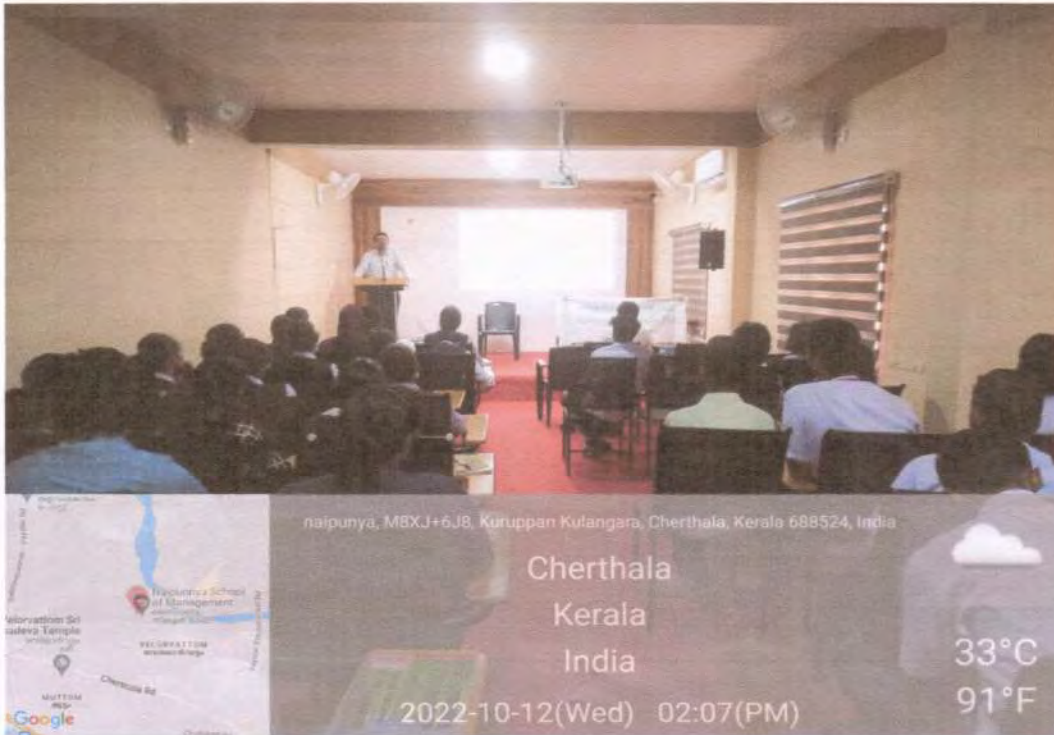


Figure 1 seminar session by Mr. Manoj Neelakandan

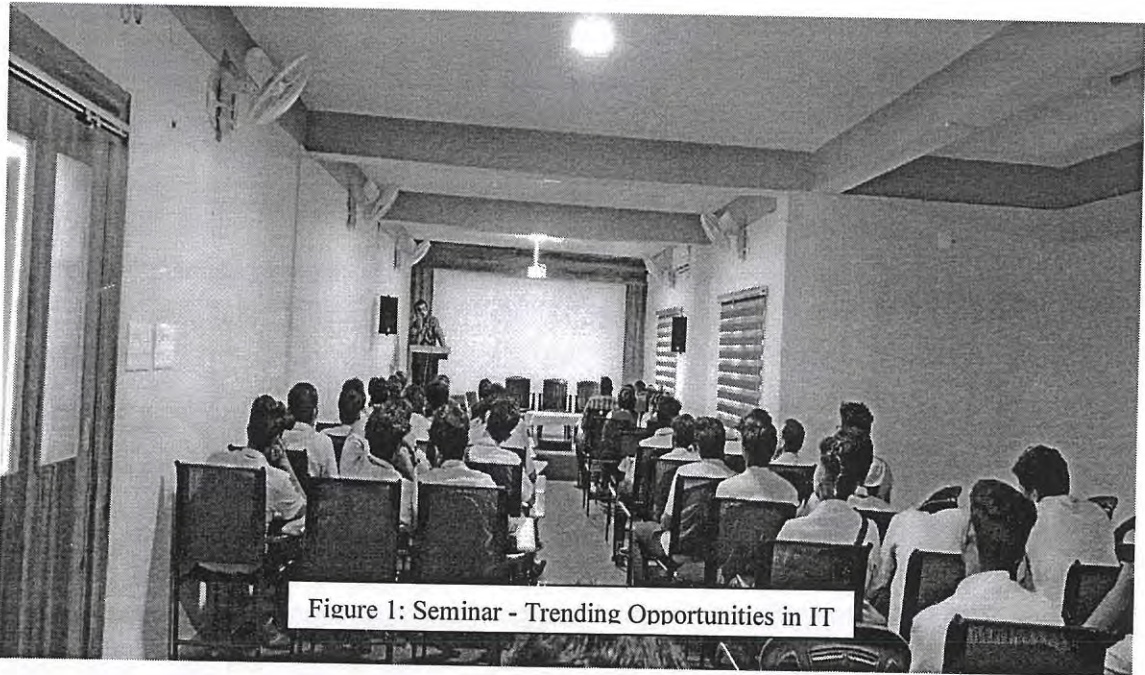


Figure 1: Seminar - Trending Opportunities in IT

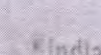
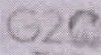
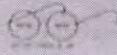
ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

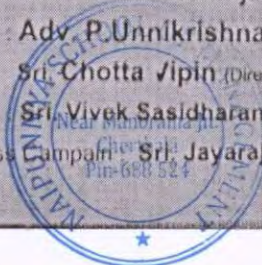

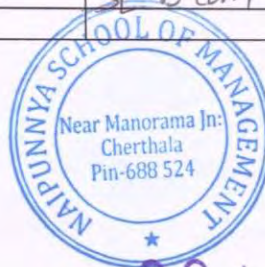

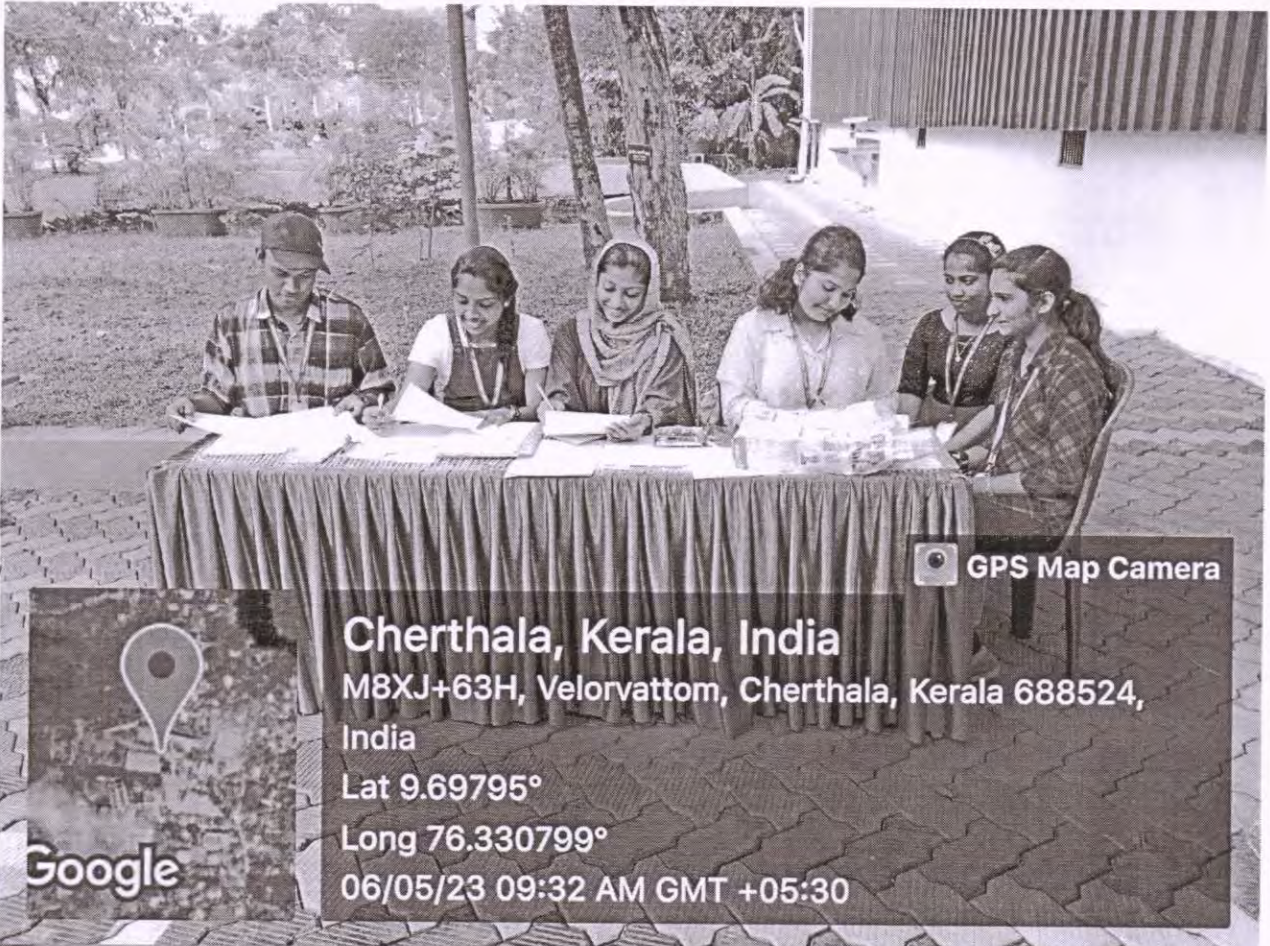
