comes to its completion with the singing of the College Anthem by the College Choir symbolizing these students as a part of the Naipunnya family. The students and the parents are reminded of the importance of their cooperation and support in being a Naipunnyan and the students take an oath refusing any drugs or such negative influences. The program comes to a conclusion with the National Anthem, followed by the HoDs and class coordinators interacting with the students and parents welcoming them to the Naipunnya fold and passing basic instructions

Phase II: Department level

- Induction programs are conducted by the departments where students of that department get an opportunity to learn more about the department and also get to know their teachers as well. Experts of the respective disciplines are invited for sessions which would help in transitioning the student to a more formal professional educational environment.

Phase III: Class Level

- These orientation programs are done to help the student understand what the subjects are and what is the expected outcome of learning that particular paper. This is done through the Bridge courses designed by the class teacher along with the subject teachers, helping the student to comprehend what is expected of them, not just academically, but etiquette-wise also. Through this process students understand the environment they are in and also attune their mind to keep up with the academic requirements.
